

Work Session Committee Minutes

September 23, 2020

Ms. Carney called the meeting to order at 6:30PM.

Members present were Jody Carney, Sherry Heineman, Shannon Pine, Frank Reed, and John Rucker.

Mayor Lane and Darren Lee were absent from the meeting.

The committee met in person to do a walking tour of the uptown area. They walked the sidewalks and discussed ideas on how to improve the sidewalks/curbs, building fronts and overall streetscape.

The committee reconvened in person and also through zoom to continue discussions about the uptown area.

The majority of the committee decided the sidewalks needed improved. Mr. Cahall said he is needing to know Council's spending limit so that he can draft a bid packet for the sidewalks. He is also seeking their input regarding a "theme" for the uptown. Mr. Reed suggested creating a development committee but Ms. Carney thought it would be best to have it on Council and Work Session Agendas for discussion instead of creating another committee.

Ms. Pine motioned, seconded by Mr. Rucker to approve A Motion Approving the Temporary Allowance for Village Employees to Accrue Vacation Leave in Excess of the Limits Established by the Village of Plain City Personnel Handbook Until December 31, 2020, in Light of The Executive Order Issued Previously This Year That Suspended the Approval of Vacation Leave for Village Employees. After Said Date, All Vacation Leave Balances in Excess of the Limits Established Shall be Reduced to the Maximum Limits. No Payouts or Carry-Forwards Shall be Allowed for Leave Balances in Excess of the Limits Allowed During This Temporary Period of Time. Five yeas votes.

Mr. Rucker said he had no issues with Mr. Dawson closing his alley to erect tents for additional dining area. Mr. Cahall and Mr. Lafayette have been reviewing maps about other potential alley vacations.
